Enter your Gmail username (everything that appears before '@gmail.com'). Enter your password. Add Gmail to an existing Google Account If you add Gmail to your Google Account, your account's primary username permanently changes to yourusername@gmail.com. After you add Gmail, the original email address associated with your account becomes your alternate email address. If you verify your original email address before you add Gmail, you can sign in with this email address. To add Gmail to your Google Account: Go to mail.google.com. Fill out the form. Click Submit. To verify your account, follow the instructions. Tip: If you use Sign in with Google or Chrome Remote Desktop and you change your primary email address, you may experience issues.
