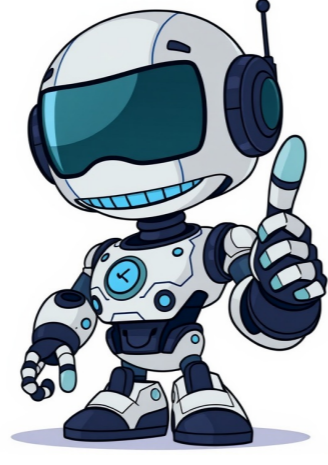

UFC 319 is set to go down on Saturday, August 16 at the United Center in Chicago, Illinois. With major storylines and high-stakes matchups, the card promises to be one of the most anticipated events of the year. In the main event, reigning middleweight champion Dricus Du Plessis defends his title against the undefeated and dangerous Khamzat Chimaev. Despite being one of the most dominant forces across any weight class or promotion, Chimaev's rise has been repeatedly interrupted by serious health issues, some of which have threatened to end his career. Still, all eyes will be on him as he looks to finally capture UFC gold. On the other side, Du Plessis has proven time and again that he's built for championship-level wars and shouldn't be overlooked. Originally slated to face Movsar Evloev in July, Aaron Pico will now make his long-awaited UFC debut in the co-main event against Lerone Murphy. Though the opponent has changed, the stakes remain high as Pico is still fighting for a number next to his name. Du Plessis had control for just 21:40 of a 25-minute fight but was unable to recover. Chimaev scored a takedown in under 30 seconds and dominated the bout. Murphy knocked out Pico cold with a picture-perfect back elbow in Round 1. Prates beat Neal via spinning elbow in Round 1. Elliott submitted Asakura via guillotine choke. Khamzat Chimaev (14-0) earned the title by defeating du Plessis. Chimaev's last bout saw him submit Whittaker, Murphy called for a title shot against Volkanovski in December. Prates beat Neal via spinning elbow. Elliott won via submission. Khamzat Chimaev will host UFC's first event in Chicago since 2019 on August 16, 2025. Khamzat Chimaev beat Dricus Du Plessis by unanimous decision in their 5 round contest during the main event of UFC 319. The scorecards were announced in favor of the winner Khamzat Chimaev. The fight was scheduled to take place over 5 rounds in the Middleweight division, which meant the weight limit was 185 pounds (13.2 stone or 83.9 KG). This contest was for the UFC Middleweight championship. Lerone Murphy was victorious over Aaron Pico with a KO in their Featherweight contest. On the main card, Geoff Neal lost to Carlos Prates by knockout in a Welterweight bout. Jared Cannonier was overcome by Michael Page by decision at Middleweight, and Tim Elliott was victorious over Kai Asakura with a submission in their Lightweight contest. Baysangur Susurkaev beat Eric Nolan with a submission in a Middleweight bout. Gerald Meerschaert was overcome by Michal Oleksiejczuk with a KO at Middleweight, Jessica Andrade was defeated by Lupita Godinez on points in their Women's Strawweight contest. Alexander Hernandez beat Chase Hooper with a KO in a Lightweight fight. Edson Barboza was overcome by Drakkar Klose on points in a Lightweight bout, Karine Silva was victorious over Dione Barbosa by decision at Women's Flyweight, and Alibi Idiris lost to Joseph Morales with a submission in their Flyweight contest.paraphrased text here Dricus du Plessis is set to face Khamzat Chimaev at UFC 319, which could be a game-changer for his career. The title fight will test du Plessis's unconventional pressure-striking style against Chimaev's wrestling-heavy approach. Du Plessis has been training hard and aims to prove himself as one of the top pound-for-pound fighters in the world. Meanwhile, Chimaev is chasing his first title win after weight-cut issues delayed his rise to fame. A victory for du Plessis would demonstrate the effectiveness of his pressure-striking strategy against elite grapplers. For Chimaev, capturing the title would validate his wrestling-heavy approach and propel him into the pantheon of all-time greats. Both fighters have impressive stats - Du Plessis lands 6.12 significant strikes per minute at 50.6% accuracy, while Chimaev boasts a staggering 4.31 takedown average at 46.7% success. The upcoming fight is expected to be intense, with du Plessis backing up to take on the wrestling-heavy Chimaev. The UFC 319 event will take place in Chicago and can be watched live on ESPN+ PPV or streamed on Kayo Sports. Fans attending the event can secure tickets here.
