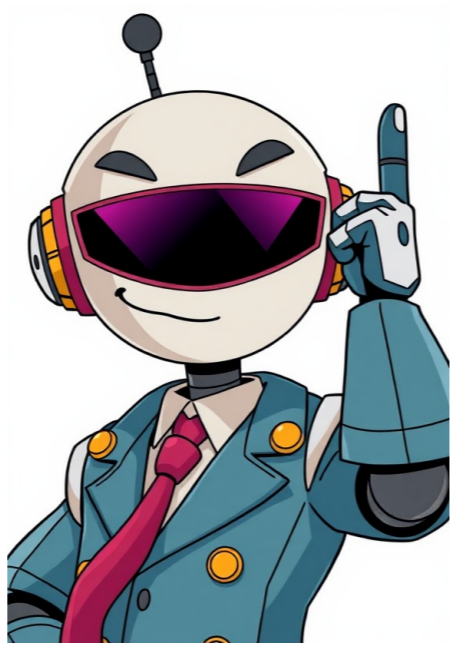

You can delete your current Google Voice number and get a new one. If you don't have a Google Voice number, sign up for Google Voice. Important: This feature operates differently based on the type of account you have. Learn more about Google Voice account types. If you have a Voice Starter standalone plan, you can delete numbers in the Google Admin console. Learn how to unassign or reassign a Voice number. You can only use credits for long-distance and international calls and texts. If you have a Voice Starter subscription, you can't purchase credits. Charges for long-distance and international paid calls and texts will appear on your monthly invoice. To make paid calls without a Google Voice subscription plan, buy credit from Google Voice. On your computer, open Google Voice. Sign in with the Google Account you used to register your number. At the top right, click Settings. On the left, click Account. Under Google Voice number, find the number you want to delete. Click Delete Delete number. When you get the message "You don't have a Google Voice number," click Get a number. Enter the city name or zip code in the search bar. If there are no numbers available in your area, try somewhere nearby. Next to the number you want, click Select. Follow the on-screen instructions. Click Address bar and search. In the "Search engine used in address bar" drop-down, click Google. In the "Search on new tabs uses search box or address bar" drop-down, click Address bar. Internet Explorer 8 & higher Tip: To find which version of Internet Explorer you're using, click Help About Internet Explorer. Internet Explorer 11 Open Internet Explorer. At the top right, click the gear icon. Click Manage add-ons. At the bottom, click Find more toolbars and extensions. Scroll down to the Google Search extension. Click Add. To confirm, click Add again. At the top right, click the gear icon. Click Manage add-ons. On the left, under "Add-on Types," click Search Providers. On the right, click Google Search. At the bottom, click Set as default. Internet Explorer 10 Open Internet Explorer. In the top right corner of the page, click the gear icon. Click Manage add-ons. On the left side of the page, click Search Providers. In the bottom left corner, click Find more providers. Select Google. Click Add to Internet Explorer. Check the box next to "Make this my default search provider." Click Add. Internet Explorer 9 Open Internet Explorer. In the top right corner of the browser, click the Tools icon. Click Internet options. In the General tab, find the "Search" section and click Settings. Select Google. Click Set as default. Click Close. Internet Explorer 8 Open Internet Explorer. Android browser Open your browser app. It could be called Internet or Browser. Tap the Menu button on your phone or at the top right of the browser. Tap Settings Advanced Set search engine. On your Android phone or tablet, open the Google app . At the top right, tap your Profile picture or initial Settings. Tap Search widget Switch to Google. Important: The name linked to your email address is not your username. You can't change your username or email address. How to change your name For example, if you get married, you could change from "Lisa Brown" at sportsfan@gmail.com to "Lisa Jones" at sportsfan@gmail.com. Important: You can't change your name from the Gmail app. On your computer, open Gmail. In the top right, click Settings See all settings. Click the Accounts and Import or Accounts tab. Under "Send mail as," click Edit info. Enter the name you want to show when you send messages. At the bottom, click Save changes. Create a new email address If you want to change your email address, sign up for a new address. After you sign up for a new address, you can transfer emails and contacts from your old address to the new one. Send a message or a file separately to each person in a conversation: Tap Group messaging Send an SMS reply to all recipients and get individual replies (mass text). Automatically download files in messages: Turn on Auto-download MMS. Automatically download files when data roams: Turn on Auto-download MMS when roaming. Use simple characters/Change number to send files Open Google Messages . Tap your profile photo or icon Settings Advanced. Change special characters to simple characters: Turn on Use simple characters. Change the phone number you use to send files: Tap Phone number. Change bubble notification settings You can keep conversations accessible with bubble notifications. When you pin bubbles to your home screen, you can get messages from contacts in fewer steps. Open Google Messages . Tap your profile photo or icon Settings Bubbles. Choose: Get notifications for all conversations: Tap All conversations can bubble. Get notifications for certain contacts: Tap Selected conversations can bubble. Stop all notifications: Tap Nothing can bubble. Tips: Change bubble settings for specific contacts: Open a conversation Tap More options Details Notifications. Dismiss a notification: Touch and hold the bubble, then drag it to the bottom of your screen. Additional controls for notifications, blocking & group messages Open Google Messages . Open a 1:1 conversation or group message. Tap More Details or More Group details. Stop message notifications: Tap Notifications Silent. Get priority notifications: Tap Notifications Priority. Block messages from the phone number or group: Tap Block & report spam OK. Optional: Check the box next to Report spam to send a spam report. Add people to the conversation: Tap Add people. Turn off link previews for websites Link previews from websites can be turned on or off: Open Google Messages . At the top right, tap your profile photo or icon Settings Automatic previews. Turn off Show all previews. Optional: To turn off previews when you send or get a link in a conversation, tap Show only web link previews. Tip: Only share links you trust. URLs can include personal details, like your location or bank information. Learn how the previews for links are created. Turn off dark theme Important: These steps only work on Android 10 and up. Open your device's Settings app . Tap Display & touch. Turn Dark theme on or off. Turn phone number verification on or off When you opt in, you allow Google to automatically verify your phone's number every now and then. You can also opt out at any time. Open your Google Settings. Depending on your phone: Open your phone's Settings app Google. Open a separate app called Google Settings. Tap Mobile data & messaging Phone Number Verification.
